**Subject:** *Subjective Test/Interview/Counselling for Provisional admission to Ph.D. Programme subject to availability of seats.*

Dear Applicant,

1. I am directed to inform you that on the basis of your application form under Direct Admission (CRET-Exempted)-2009, and as per your first preference you are required to report for Subjective Test/Interview/ Counselling for possible provisional admission to Ph.D. Programme subject to availability of seats in the Institute for the Academic Session 2009-10 (July 2009 Semester).
2. Please report personally to the concerned Head/Coordinator of the Department/School, IT-BHU **as per schedule at 10.30 a.m.** alongwith all required documents in original (listed in Para 4 below) and the enclosed proforma duly filled in. Please also note that in case you fail to report on above date alongwith required documents you shall forfeit your claim for consideration for Interview/Test/Counselling. The Test/Interview/Counselling will be held on **as per schedule at 10.30 a.m. in the Chamber of the Dean, Faculty of Engineering and Technology.**
3. The candidates may have to stay for about 3-4 days in case he/she is interested in registration in the department/school to go through the process of selection to determine/identify the candidates to be register in the Ph.D.

**Note:** 1. Please bear in mind that the number of eligible candidates called for Subjective Test/Interview/Counselling is much larger than the seats available in the concerned department/ school where you are seeking admission. Therefore, mere receipt of the Call Letter does not entitle you for provisional admission. The admission of the eligible candidates shall be made strictly on the basis of merit index calculated on the basis of performance and academic record against the available seats. No eligible candidate shall advance any claim, whatsoever, for the provisional admission if seats are not vacant at the time of consideration of his/her candidature for admission.

2. A Candidate may be admitted for the Ph.D. Programme at the beginning of July semester provided the result of the qualifying examination is declared before the commencement of the semester at the IT, i.e., 30.06.2008 and he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria laid down in these ordinances.
4. You must produce the under-mentioned documents in **ORIGINAL** at the time of counselling for provisional admission before the Admission Committee for its perusal and scrutiny/ verification. Failure to produce any of these documents on any ground may disqualify the candidate from the provisional admission.
  - (i) **Mark-Sheets** of the **QUALIFYING EXAMINATION** and all other examinations passed by you. *(Only the proper mark-sheet shall be accepted. Any other document (other than a proper mark-sheet issued by an authority like Vice-Chancellor/Rector/PVC/Registrar/CE etc. with regard to marks obtained by a candidate shall not be entertained)*
  - (ii) **Caste Certificate** issued by the appropriate authority, if admission is sought under SC/ST Category.
  - (iii) **Physically Challenged (PC)** candidates will have to submit a Disability Certificate issued by the District CMO.
  - (iv) **Character Certificate** issued by the institution last attended.
  - (v) **Transfer Certificate (TC) and Migration Certificate**, in original, for those candidates who are not studying any course at present. Those who are studying some course at present have to give an undertaking to submit the T.C. and Migration Certificate within one month of registration if offered registration in BHU.

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*Under exceptional situation a candidate may be allowed to submit the migration certificate beyond a period of 30 days but not later than 90 days from the date of his/her provisional admission.*

- (vi) Valid NET/GATE certificate; in case of BHU Teacher, certificate of holding substantive teaching post in BHU issued from the concerned Head/Coordinator duly endorsed by the respective Director/Dean and in case of QIP/FIP candidate, certificate of sponsorship under QIP/FIP and NOC from the concerned employer.
- (vii) The candidate is required to submit 3 (three) self-attested copies of each of the documents mentioned above and also four (4) copies of self-attested passport size photographs identical to one pasted on the Application Form.

### **IMPORTANT GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Candidates must read carefully the under mentioned general information and conditions for the provisional admission. Non-compliance of any condition shall disqualify a candidate for provisional admission.**

1. The Institute/University shall not be responsible in any manner for postal delay and/or non-delivery of the Call Letter in time.
2. The candidates claiming admission under Physically Challenged (PC) category and eligible for counseling will be examined by a Medical Board constituted by BHU and if necessary, will be referred by the Medical Board to other recognized bodies for the purpose, as per the criteria fixed by the University. Such candidates must have studied in the Schools for Blind students or Integrated Schools for Disabled persons.
3. The admission of any candidate is liable to be cancelled without giving further notice forthwith or at any time during the period of the Ph.D. Programme if it is detected later on, that the candidate has/had produced fake/forged certificate(s)/ document(s), indulged in any act of misconduct/indiscipline/ moral turpitude and has/had concealed any other relevant information at the time of seeking provisional admission. Such a candidate is also liable to be prosecuted under the law of the land besides being debarred from appearing in any of the Entrance Test of BHU in future.
4. Any attempt by the candidates or anyone else on his/her behalf to influence and/or pressurize any authorities/Admission Committee or University directly/indirectly for his/her out of rules admission, shall disqualify the candidate from the provisional admission. Such candidates shall also liable to be prosecuted under the law of the land.
5. The provisional admission of the candidate to the Ph.D. programme shall be subject to Ph.D. ordinances, rules and regulations as framed and concerned from time to time by the University.
6. **Hostel accommodation is not guaranteed.**
7. The date of commencement of Semester of the Ph.D. programme shall be as per the time schedule prescribed by the Institute/Department/School.
8. Candidate provisionally selected for admission shall be required to collect his/her letter of admission from the concerned Department/School and also deposit the prescribed fee by the date as decided by the Committee failing which he/she shall forfeit his/her claim for the provisional admission.
9. Only the local Court of Varanasi/Honourable High Court of Judicature at Allahabad/Honorable Supreme Court of India shall have jurisdiction in case of any dispute relating to the provisional admission.
